Updates on Lindley Elementary Construction (Kevin Smith):

- -issues with the facilities-need updating for the kids and community long term
- -preliminary work-surveyors here next week
- -likely no significant changes/construction until the end of the next school year (2025)
- -will likely move out and be displaced for a couple of years once construction starts
- -Keep Informed through GCS app-select Lindley Elementary to keep up to date with school info
- -there will be opportunity for community input to developers (i.e., preservation of spaces like the outdoor amphitheater).
- -STEM school is no longer on the table.
- -increased capacity for 700 students with the renovation

District 3- Ken Jones-

- -Short term rentals and impact in the neighborhood, there will be some official things coming out on what to do if you are having issues.
- -(a side note) City is in the process of changing the "additional dwelling unit" in the zoning rules (making it easier to get them than before).
- -In the last weekly email, there was a list of #s that are resources to reach out if you are having issues with an air-B-and B type property issues.

Danny's Auto Shop (Danny and Danny Jr.)-

-Adjacent property to his shop was sold and the new owners are using it as a junk yard and car towing lot. The company is A to Z Towing (tow across from Spring Garden) is keeping the cars

they tow next door and people are coming to their house/property knocking at all hours with no one on the property.

Elizabeth -has talked to code enforcement at the City, notice of violation when half the building burned down, now sold to A and Z towing, working on clearing it out and cleaning it up, the owner has been made aware that if he wants to use it as a salvage yard that he will have to apply (minimum lot size is 5 acres, at least 300 liner feet from residential use requirements and it is not currently either of these) for a variance for the board of adjustments. If he gets approval, he will have to do landscape improvements that are required of a salvage yard. She suggests that they call 336-373-CITY and speak with Tonya Rumley.

Committee Reports:

Communication:

- -Survey coming out soon to see what people want to see in the newsletter (ads are paying for the printing-Danny's auto advertises there)

Zoning and Development:

- -We need someone to attend a city meeting with community resource officer quarterly (we need someone to volunteer to attend).
- -Kellyn Foundation (church at corner of Holden and Walker) are moving in now.
- -Brooks Global (Mary Alice-Brooks liaison)-
 - -500 students future enrollment (current enrollment is 312)
- -building is on time-August 20^{th,} 2024 expected to finish construction (Going to open Jan of 2025).
- -With Brooks and Lindley rebuild being in the same neighborhood this will bring up some issues, so will be doing an extensive traffic "impact analysis" study. This will be a more expansive study that will incorporate both schools and surrounding areas.
- -updating neighborhood plan soon-if you would like to get involved please reach out
- -Plans for Lindley pool are being updated, but until further notice, it will be closed
- -Brice St. Park (near Mayflower area)- planning to update it
- -Mo Jud Apartments are starting to open (will likely need a new traffic study at Howard st)
- -Apartments planned for Hyatt st
- -Apartments in Starmount Koury development on Market St.

Recycling Center:

-beginning to explore-something in the neighborhood (glass, Styrofoam, compost-would be a pilot program and there is a fee)—possible locations-Lindley Rec, Bestway, or Lindley School.
